

THE HISTORY OF MANITOU SPRINGS

COLORADO'S FIRST RESORT DESTINATION

Long before European explorers came to the Front Range of the Colorado Rockies, the Indigenous Peoples of the region knew the benefits of the bubbling soda and iron springs at the base of their sacred mountain Tavakiev, known today as Pikes Peak.

The nations of the Arapaho, Cheyenne, Shoshone, Kiowa, Comanche, Apache and many more frequently visited on their migrations across the eastern plains while the Utes considered the springs as part of their mountain homeland from which they originated and never left for long.

Though frequently enemies, most would practice restraint in the valley of what they traditionally called the medicine springs.

The effervescent waters, either drunk or bathed in, provided comfort from pain and toil, especially as they were set in a scenic canyon full of game and protected by the great mountain. Today, the local community and visitors alike recognize and acknowledge the sacred land and the original peoples of this area.

EARLY EXPLORERS

The Spanish were the first Europeans to travel through the area, followed by French fur trappers, who named the creek running next to the springs "Fountaine qui Bouille" or Boiling Fountain, now just Fountain Creek. With the Louisiana Purchase, the United States sent Lt. Zebulon Pike and company to explore the new territory in 1806. Though he would miss the springs entirely, Pike's attempted climb of the mountain that carries his name brought attention to the region.

Dr. Edwin James, botanist of the 1820 Long Expedition, was the first American to climb the peak and write about the springs and their health benefits. Daniel Boone's grandson, Col. A. G. Boone, visited the area for the health of his sons in 1833 and Capt. John C. Fremont, the "Pathfinder of the West," reported on his scientific findings at these medicinal springs during his 1842 expedition.

By far the most widely read review of Manitou's charms was penned by English officer and adventurer George Fredrick Ruxton, whose 1847 travels to the area are chronicled in his book "Adventures in Mexico and the Rocky Mountains". He described the picturesque location and the superior quality of the mineral water which "hissed and sparkled" in his cup, declaring it possessed of "that fresh, natural flavor which manufactured water cannot impart."

Once the 59'ers started to flock to Colorado during the Pikes Peak or Bust gold rush, traffic increased dramatically as fortune hunters used Ute Pass as a route to the gold fields. By 1868 the Cheyenne and Arapaho were removed to reservations and the Utes met the same fate by 1880, separated from the sacred places of their ancestors. In 1868, Gen. William Jackson Palmer, railroad engineer, and Dr. William A. Bell, physician, investigated the already famous medicine springs while on the Kansas and Pacific Railroad survey. Palmer was already envisioning a railroad from Colorado to Mexico and a European-style health resort built around the springs would be a tremendous drawing card for this endeavor.

MANITOU'S FOUNDING 151 YEARS AGO

William Palmer, Dr. Bell, and a group of investors created the Colorado Springs Company to develop their newly purchased lands east of Pikes Peak in 1871. The first stake pounded into the prairie that was then known as Fountain Colony happened on August 9, 1871, with the newly laid out lots intended for schools, churches, farming, and settlers. However, the land around the mineral springs then named La Font was intended for a different purpose.



The company hired John Blair, wellknown landscape designer and gardener from Chicago to lay out the lots of the new town and the park that would surround the springs. In the surrounding hills would be villas and cottages catering to those wealthy health seekers desiring a summer home in the Rockies.

The Colorado Springs Company also took the advice of British collector and investor William Blackmore and, in June of 1871, renamed their fledgling settlements Colorado Springs and Manitou. Palmer himself was one of the first residents of Manitou as he built a "Temporary Inn" in what is now Soda Springs Park to house himself and visitors while his home Glen Eyrie was being constructed. By January of 1872, the land had been surveyed, lots laid out, and Manitou was officially declared a town, making 2022 its Sesquicentennial year of founding.

SARATOGA OF THE WEST

The first hotel, the Manitou House, was completed in August of 1872 and the era of the health resort began. Thousands of sufferers from tuberculosis and digestive disease flocked to the dry air and healing waters of Manitou and many other hotels, boarding houses, and bath houses were soon built to accommodate.

Even through the economic recessions of 1873 and 1893, Manitou continued its steady growth to become one of America's premier health destinations by 1900. The mineral water was so popular that bath houses were constructed in 1873, 1883 and 1920 in an era when hotels only had one bathroom per floor.

Bottling of Manitou's mineral waters was attempted early on as well, but the natural carbonation was so intense that the bottles regularly exploded. With



the construction of the 1889 Manitou Mineral Water Co.'s bottling plant and its associated Colorado City Glass Factory, locally made and stronger bottles meant that the healthy, effervescent beverage could be shipped to dealers all over the country and abroad, further advertising the fame of its town of origin.

Well known celebrities of the era like President Ulysses S. Grant, Buffalo Bill, Gen. William Tecumseh Sherman, Thomas Edison and Lily Langtry mixed with captains of industry and their families in Manitou. Each of the seven grand hotels held a ball known as a "hop" on consecutive nights. Scenic drives, the Cog Railway up Pikes Peak, and promenades from spring to spring were other popular pastimes. There were also thriving shops in the downtown area like curio stores, jewelry stores, photography studios and a great many doctor's offices to cater to ailing visitors.

After the turn of the last century, tourists began replacing the health seekers and attractions became even more important. The Cave of the Winds, the Cliff Dwellings, two incline railways and at least four popular dance halls all brought even more admirers to Manitou. This era of the automobile also ushered in a new way to travel, and auto court motels began to populate the east end of town along with more roads to the area.

SAD TIMES LEAD TO GLAD TIMES AGAIN

The Depression and WWII took a toll on this tourist economy and, by the 1960's, Manitou Springs had seen better days. All but 3 of the grand hotels had burned down, the historic neighborhoods in the hills were run down, and the commercial district barely functioned except in the summer.

The 1970's marked a turning point for the valley of the mineral springs. A National Historic District was established, spurring restoration of many commercial buildings and older homes. An art colony began to grow and prosper with the formation of cooperatives. Traditional attractions were rediscovered, and new amenities offered. In 1987 the Mineral Springs Foundation was organized and many of the traditional springs are now accessible again. Through a reexamination and revitalization of the best of its past, Manitou Springs has forged a unique future to share with all.

REFLECTING ON THE PROFOUND QUESTION, "WHAT LAND DO YOU **BELONG TO?"**

This transports us to the cultural heritage embedded in Tava (Sun Mountain). This inquiry, a customary greeting among the Ute, Chevenne, Apache, Comanche, and more, extends beyond a mere geographical identifier. Tava represents an energetic binding—a community where roots run deep, entwining individuals within a tribe or community. To those who belong to her, Tava is not just a mountain; she is a spiritual journey, an entity where a collective oneness thrives.

In delving into the essence of Tava, envision her heart as composed of the golden quivering leaves of Aspen, her breath as the sweet essence exuded by blue spruce and ponderosa pine. Her blood symbolically courses through the veins of all creatures tending to her forest, and her spirit resonates in every individual inspired by her presence.

Contemplating the proposal to restore the ancient name Tava to Pikes Peak prompts a deeper reflection on one's connection to the land. This discourse arises within discussions surrounding the iconic Pikes Peak, situated in the traditional territories of the Ute people. The proposed change, rooted in the Ute language where "Tava" translates to "Sun Mountain," underscores a broader nationwide movement to honor and acknowledge indigenous histories.

Pikes Peak, with its deep cultural significance to the Ute Nation, becomes a focal point for

recognizing their rich heritage that predates the region's more recent history. Advocates argue that renaming the peak to Tava is not just a symbolic gesture; it's a meaningful step toward acknowledging the profound relationship the Ute people hold with the sun and the land enveloping the majestic peak.

This proposed renaming aligns with a national initiative aimed at rectifying historical inaccuracies, paying homage to indigenous cultures, and fostering inclusivity. The discourse extends beyond a mere change in nomenclature; it's a commitment to a more accurate representation of the cultural tapestry that defines the region.

Media outlets such as The Gazette and Denver Post have delved into this evolving narrative, capturing perspectives from diverse stakeholders, including indigenous communities, historians, and local leaders. As these discussions progress, a crucial aspect lies in engaging in respectful dialogue, considering historical contexts, and actively seeking input from the Ute community. This ensures that any potential renaming becomes a collaborative and meaningful process, reflective of the collective identity woven into the fabric of Tava's legacy.





For thousands of years, indigenous people passing through the region stopped in the valley of the "Medicine" springs to drink and bathe in the water and pay homage to the healing spirits of the mineral springs. The town of Manitou Springs was founded in the early 1870s as a resort for travelers from the east seeking the relief of the healing waters and the dry mountain air.

Now there are eight naturally carbonated mineral springs throughout the Manitou Springs Historic District. All bubble up from the karst aquifer deep under the town, where the water is permeated with natural carbonation as it is forced to the surface.

Minerals from the surrounding rock dissolve into the water for distinctive benefits. The cool, refreshing water is available and easily accessible for tasting from unique, artistic fonts. Springs are tested regularly to ensure purity. Each spring has a different taste.

Enjoy a self-guided tour of the mineral springs. For a small fee pick up a sipping cup and map at the Manitou Springs Visitors Center at 354 Manitou Avenue.



IRON SPRING

Iron Spring was once the most popular spring in Manitou, when thousands of health-seekers traveled up Ruxton Avenue to drink its iron-infused waters. The current spring was drilled in

1910. It was made more popular by adding orange and lemon flavoring for taste.



STRATTON SPRING

Drilled by the Stratton Foundation during the Great Depression as a service to the town, this popular spring stands at the intersection of indigenous trails, the historic trolley lines,

and the modern highway system.



TWIN SPRING

Twin Spring is the locals' favorite spring for its sweet taste and for making Manitou Lemonade or Manitou Mojitos. Originally two springs, Twin Spring now has been merged into one font.



CHEYENNE SPRING

One of the mineral springs once utilized by the Manitou Mineral Water Company's bottling operations is housed in the round stone spring house nearby. The red orange Lyons sandstone for

the spring house was sourced from nearby Kenmuir Quarry, now Red Rock Canyon Open Space. The mineral water flows from the original basin to a bronze font.



SHOSHONE SPRING

A natural spring with the highest levels of many minerals, Shoshone Spring was highly recommended by the physicians of the 1800s for its curative and healing properties.



NAVAJO SPRING

Navajo Spring was near the Ute Pass Trail and was a rendezvous for indigenous peoples, explorers and early settlers. The font is located on the back outside wall of current-day Patsy's

Candies Store. The candy store was originally a sampling room for the bottling works.



WHEELER SPRING

Wheeler Spring was donated to the city by the family of Jerome Wheeler, mining and railroad magnate, banker, one-time president of Macy's department store, and chief promoter/

president of the Manitou Mineral Water Company.






